THE WOMEN'S AND MAIDS' NYLON STOCKINGS (DISTRIBUTORS' MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The maximum price to be charged in the course of the business of a retailer on a sale of women's and maids' new nylon stockings (other than fully fashioned stockings) shall be the amount specified in Column 2 of the First Schedule hereto.
2. The maximum price to be charged in the course of the business of a retailer on a sale of women's and maids' new fully fashioned nylon stockings shall be the aggregate of the following amounts:-
 - (a) the purchase price paid or agreed to be paid by the first purchaser, being a retailer;
 - (b) an amount equal to 33 1/3rd. per cent thereof; and
 - (c) an amount equal to 2 1/2 per cent of the aggregate of the foregoing amounts;

Provided that the maximum price shall not exceed the appropriate amount specified in Column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto.

3. (1) Every person who carries on any undertaking by way of trade or business in the course of which he sells by retail nylon stockings, shall keep or cause to be kept an accurate record of all purchases by him of such stockings, that record to include in respect of each purchase the name and address of the person from whom the stockings were purchased, particulars of the quantity and description thereof and of the price paid or charged.
- (2) Retention by any person of an invoice or of a copy of an invoice shall, as respects the particulars mentioned in that document, be sufficient compliance by that person with the provisions of this Article.
- (3) Every person who is required by this Article to keep any record shall retain it for a period of not less than two years from the date of the transaction to which it relates.

4. (1) In this Order -

"maximum price" means the price, from which the cost actually paid or incurred of delivering those stockings may be excluded, payable before any deduction by way of discount;

"purchase price" means the price after all deductions by way of discount other than cash or settlement discounts not exceeding 5 per cent, and delivery charges may be included in the calculation of the purchase price of any stockings except where the price of the stockings purchased, or, if the stockings were included in a parcel comprising other articles, the price of the parcel did not exceed £2.

(2) The Women's and Maids' Nylon Hose (Distributors' Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952, dated 8th March, 1952 (a) is hereby revoked.

(3) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

5. This Order may be cited as The Women's and Maids' Nylon Stockings (Distributors' Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 15th day of April, 1952.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order supersedes The Women's and Maids' Nylon Hose (Distributors' Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952.

The principal changes are:-

- (a) the maximum prices now fixed for nylon stockings are the same whether they bear the utility mark or not;
- (b) the categories in which nylon stockings are grouped have been re-arranged;
- (c) maximum prices for nylon stockings which are not fully fashioned are now the amounts specified in the First Schedule; hitherto the prices have been fixed by reference to the purchase price and the appropriate margin subject to an overriding maximum price;
- (d) the margins which may now be added to the purchase prices of fully fashioned nylon stockings for the purpose of computing their maximum prices are lower than those which could previously be added for non-utility nylon stockings but higher than those which could be added for utility nylon stockings;
- (e) the Order reduces the overriding maximum prices for fully fashioned 15 denier nylon stockings; in other cases the new overriding maximum prices are below the old non-utility overriding maximum prices, and, for stockings previously in the utility range, are approximately at the levels at which the overriding maximum prices of utility nylon stockings were previously fixed;
- (f) invoices are to be preserved for a period of two years; and
- (g) the overriding maximum prices given in the First and Second Schedules include the $2\frac{1}{2}$ per cent margin allowed to retailers to cover local charges.
