IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946.

IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949,
AMENDMENT NO. 2 ORDER, 1952.

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of its powers under the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The importation of racing or other pigeons from the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick and the Isle of Man is hereby prohibited.
2. The exportation of racing or other pigeons to the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick and the Isle of Man is hereby prohibited.
3. The importation of cats and dogs from the Island of Jersey is hereby prohibited.
4. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
5. This Order shall come into force on the 7th day of May, 1952, and may be cited as "The Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment No. 2 Order, 1952."
