IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946.

IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949,
AMENDMENT No. 3 ORDER, 1952.

The Board of Administration in pursuance of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The Second Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, (a) as amended shall be further amended by deleting the item "Cream Canned" and substituting therefor the item "Cream".
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into force on the 29th day of May, 1952, and may be cited as the "Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment No. 3 Order, 1952."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of the above Order is that as from the 29th May, 1952, the exportation from Guernsey of cream is prohibited, except under licence issued by the States Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities.
