The Plants and Potatoes Importation Ordinance, 1951.

General Licence (I.P.P. Gen. 1. 1952).

In accordance with the provisions of section 6 of the Plants and Potatoes Importation Ordinance, 1951, the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries hereby authorises as follows: -

1. The General Licence (I.P.P.Gen. 2./1951),(a), dated the 24th/February, 1951, shall be amended by inserting in subsection A of section 1 thereof after the words "Raw Fruit" the words "(other than raw cherries)".
2. The landing or transshipment in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm or Jethou of consignments of raw cherries grown in -
  - (i) any country other than a European country, without restriction;
  - (ii) any European country other than Spain, Portugal, France, Italy, Austria, Bulgaria, Hungary, Yugo-Slavia, Switzerland, Czecho-Slovakia, and Germany, provided that each consignment is accompanied by a certificate signed by a duly authorised officer of the Government of the country of origin, stating the country and place where the raw cherries were grown;
  - (iii) France, provided that each consignment is accompanied by a certificate issued by an officer of the French Phytopathological Service in the form set out in the Schedule to this Licence.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Licence as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Licence shall come into operation on the 1st June, 1952, and shall expire on the 30th September, 1952, after which date the General Licence (I.P.P. Gen.2./1951),(a), shall be read and have effect as if this Licence had not been made.
