IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949,
AMENDMENT NO. 4 ORDER, 1952

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of its powers under the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. There shall be inserted in the Second Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, (a), the following item:-

"Feeding Stuffs for Poultry".
2. The Delegation of Power to Grant Export Licences (No. 1) Order, 1949, (b) as amended, shall be further amended as follows:-

After the words "Feeding Stuffs for Animals" insert the words "and poultry".
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into force on the 12th day of June, 1952, and may be cited as the "Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment No. 4 Order, 1952".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of this Order is that as from the 12th June, 1952, the exportation of Feeding Stuffs for poultry is prohibited except under licence issued by the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries.

THE CONTROL OF AVIATION SPIRIT (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. In Article one of the Control of Aviation Spirit (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952, (a) (which restricts the supply and acquisition of aviation spirit for use in civil aviation to sixty-five per centum of the quantities supplied or acquired during the month of April), for the words "sixty-five" there shall be substituted the words "seventy-eight".
2. This Order may be cited as the Control of Aviation Spirit (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 31st day of May, 1952.

This Order increases the amount of aviation spirit which may be acquired or supplied during the period of four weeks beginning on the 12th May, 1952, to 78 per cent of the amount acquired or supplied during the month of April, 1952.

THE EXPORT OF TOMATOES (ZONING) NO. 2 ORDER, 1952.

The States Committee for Horticulture, in pursuance of paragraph 5 (2) of the Export of Tomatoes (No. 2) Order, 1952, (a) hereby directs:-

1. The change of zones as regards permitted shipping days will take place during the week ending June 14th, 1952.
2. During the week ending June 14th, shipping days for the two zones shall be as follows:-

Monday, June 9th. }
Wednesday, June 11th. } Southern Zone.

Tuesday, June 10th. }
Thursday, June 12th. } Northern Zone.

Friday, June 13th. Both Zones.

Saturday, June 14th. Southern Zone.

3. The shipping days for the zones from Saturday, June 14th until further notice are therefore as follows:-

Northern Zone - Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Southern Zone - Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.

4. This Order shall not apply to growers and packers, who, by arrangement with the Tomato Shipping Board, ship every day.
5. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
