IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949,
AMENDMENT NO. 6 ORDER, 1952

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949 (a), as amended, shall have effect subject to the following amendments:-
 - (a) after Article 2 thereof there shall be inserted the following article:-

"2 A. Nothing in any licence granted under Article 2 hereof after the 8th day of July, 1952, shall authorise the importation into Guernsey of goods of any description specified in Part I. of the Third Schedule hereto, being goods originating in, or consigned from, any country other than a country specified in Part II. of that Schedule, unless the importation of those goods is expressly authorised by the licence" and
 - (b) there shall be added as the Third Schedule thereto, the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into force on the 8th day of July, 1952, and may be cited as the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment No. 6 Order, 1952.

SCHEDULE

(THIRD SCHEDULE TO S.I. 1949 No. 45)

PART I.

DESCRIPTION OF GOODS

1. Articles of all kinds suitable for use for or in connection with the celebration or commemoration of the Coronation of Her Majesty or as souvenirs thereof, being articles which consist of or bear a representation of Her Majesty, any member of the Royal Family, the Royal Cypher, the Royal Arms, any Royal emblem, escutcheon, badge, crest, armorial bearings or insignia, any article or building associated with the Coronation, or a flag of any country specified in Part II. hereof, or which consist of or bear any other mark or device which renders them suitable for use as aforesaid.
2. Flags of any country so specified and flags resembling any such flag.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order amends the Import and Export (Control)(Guernsey) Order, 1949.

Articles, suitable for use in connection with the Coronation and described in the Schedule, originating in or consigned from any country other than one specified in the Schedule, may not be imported under a licence unless that licence expressly authorises their importation.
