IMPORT DUTIES.

THE IMPORT DUTIES (No. 26) ORDER (BAILLICK OF GUERNSEY), 1952, DATED 8th JULY, 1952, MADE BY THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, BY VIRTUE OF THE IMPORT DUTIES LAWS (BAILLICK OF GUERNSEY), 1932 TO 1947.

WHEREAS the Import Duties Laws (Bailiwick of Guernsey), 1932 to 1947, provide that (subject to the limitation therein provided) the Board of Administration may, by Order, direct that there shall be chargeable on goods imported into the Bailiwick such duties as may be specified in the Order ;

AND WHEREAS the said Laws empower the said Board of Administration, by Order, to vary or revoke any duties chargeable by virtue of any previous Order ;

Now, therefore, the Board of Administration, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the said Laws by resolution of the said Board of the 8th July, 1952, does hereby order as follows :—

1. The Appendix of the Import Duties (No. 25) Order (Bailiwick of Guernsey), 1951, (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Order”) shall be amended as follows :—

Part 3

GROUP IV

Sub-paragraphs (ii) and (iii) of paragraph (1) shall be deleted.

Sub-paragraph (v) of paragraph (1) shall be re-numbered sub-paragraph (vi).

GROUP V

The words “and does not exceed £70 per ton” shall be deleted from section (c) of sub-paragraph (iv) of paragraph (3)

Section (d) of sub-paragraph (iv) of paragraph (3) shall be deleted.

Sub-paragraph (viii) of paragraph (5) shall be deleted.

The words “but not horse shoe nails” shall be inserted immediately after the word “spikes” in line 2 of sub-paragraph (xiii) of paragraph (5)

GROUP VI

There shall be inserted, as a note to sub-paragraph (iii) of paragraph (5), the following :—

“ This heading does not cover hasps of base metal which are chargeable at the rate of 10 per cent only (see Table A, paragraph (19)). ”

The note to sub-paragraph (iv) of paragraph (6) shall be amended to read :—

“ This duty is temporarily suspended, for a period ending on 31st December, 1952. ”

GROUP VII

Paragraph (4) shall be deleted.

GROUP VIII

Sub-paragraphs (iii) and (iv) of paragraph (1) shall be deleted.

The note to section (a) of sub-paragraph (iv) of paragraph (1) shall be amended to read :—

“ Electrically operated hair clippers are chargeable with duty at the rate of 15 per cent. (See Group X(4) (vi), page 78). ”

Sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (2) shall be deleted.

Sub-paragraphs (iv) and (vi) of paragraph (4) shall be deleted.

GROUP IX

Sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (2) shall be deleted.

GROUP X

In the List of Exceptions at the end of paragraph (1)—

(a) Section (j) shall be re-lettered section (i);

(b) There shall be inserted, as sections (j), (k) and (l) respectively, the following:—

“(j) Electric motor and generator casings and unwound rotors and stators

(k) Sand blast nozzles lined with material wholly or mainly of silicon carbide or tungsten carbide

(l) Grinding wheels of a diameter of not less than 54 inches and made wholly or mainly of agglomerated natural stone.”

(c) There shall be inserted, as a note to section (j), the following:—

“ See Table A, paragraph (18).”

Sub-paragraphs (i) and (iv) of paragraph (2) shall be deleted.

Sub-paragraph (x) of paragraph (5) shall be deleted.

Sub-paragraphs (i) and (x) of paragraph (8) shall be deleted.

Sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (12) shall be deleted.

GROUP XI

Paragraph (10) shall be deleted.

There shall be inserted, as a note to section (k) of the List of Exceptions to paragraph (1), the following :—

“ See Table A, paragraph (27).”

GROUP XII

Section (a) of the List of Exceptions to paragraph (2) shall be amended to read :—

“ Goods comprised in heading (a) of sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (6) of Group XV or in sub-paragraphs (iv) or (ix) of paragraph (1) of this Group ;”

GROUP XIII

The footnote to paragraph (6) shall be amended to read :—

“ See Table A, paragraph (20).”

GROUP XIV

Section (b) of sub-paragraph (i), and sub-paragraph (iii) of paragraph (3) shall be deleted.

GROUP XV

The words " of leather over $\frac{1}{8}$ inch thick and not more than 24 inches wide, of a value not less than £30 per cwt." shall be deleted from section (d) of the List of Exceptions to paragraph (1).

Paragraph (3) shall be deleted and paragraphs (4) and (5) shall be re-numbered paragraphs (5) and (6) respectively.

GROUP XVI

There shall be inserted, as a note to paragraph (3), the following:—

" See Table A, paragraph (22)."

GROUP XVII

Paragraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4) shall be deleted.

GROUP XVIII

Paragraphs (7), (8), (17), (20), (21) and (26), and sub-paragraph (vii) of paragraph (14), shall be deleted.

The words " push buttons " shall be deleted from sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (10), and there shall be inserted, as a note to the said sub-paragraph (i), the following:—

" See Table A, paragraph (23) "

There shall be inserted, as a note to sub-paragraph (vii) of paragraph (14), the following:—

" See Table A, paragraph (25) "

There shall be inserted, as a note to Section (c) of the List of Exceptions to paragraph (17), the following :—

“ See Table A, paragraph (26)”

Section (c) of sub-paragraph (iii) of paragraph (19) shall be re-lettered section (d).

There shall be inserted, as a note to sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (26), the following :—

“ See Table A, paragraph (21), as regards certain parts of organs.”

The Annex to the Schedule of Duties shall be deleted.

Part 5.

Paragraphs (21) and (22) shall be deleted.

Part 6.

Under the heading “Fruit, dried or otherwise preserved, viz :—”

the item :—

“ Figs and fig cake 7s. per cwt.” shall be deleted.

2. There shall be inserted in the first and second columns respectively of the Appendix to the principal Order, in the respective places specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order, the words and figures contained in the second and third columns respectively of the Schedule to this Order,

3. The provisions of the Import Duties Laws (Bailiwick of Guernsey), 1932 to 1947, shall apply to all the articles set out in the Schedule to this Order and duty shall be charged thereon at the rates set out in that Schedule.

4. This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (No. 26) Order (Bailiwick of Guernsey), 1952.

5. This Order shall come into operation in the Islands of Guernsey and Alderney on the 1st day of August, 1952, and in the Island of Sark so soon thereafter as the provisions of the said Laws with reference to the putting into operation therein of this Order shall have been complied with.


