THE FUEL (MAXIMUM PRICES) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. (a) In this Order -

"Buy" includes offer or agree to buy and "sell" includes offer or agree to sell or expose for sale.

"Imported" means imported from the United Kingdom.

*referred to by S.I. 149 (1952)*

(b) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

2. No person shall buy or sell any fuel of a description appearing in the Schedule to this Order at a price exceeding the price applicable thereto in accordance with the provisions of the said Schedule.

3. This Order shall not apply in relation to fuel for use for Horticultural purposes.

4. The following Orders are hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof:-

(a) The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1951, dated 28th April, 1951 (a).

(b) The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1952, dated 28th January, 1952 (b).

(c) The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) (Amendment No. 4) Order, 1952, dated 27th May, 1952 (c).

5. This Order may be cited as The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1952, and shall come into force on the 2nd day of August, 1952.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order, which supersedes The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1951, as amended, provides maximum selling prices for solid fuel on sales other than for horticultural purposes. The only change is the fixing of maximum prices of 8s. 1d. per cwt. delivered and 7s. 7d. per cwt. ex merchants' store for imported coke.
