THE FATS, CHEESE AND TEA (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)  
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952 (a), shall be amended by substituting for the Schedule thereto the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 10th day of August, 1952.

1. The amount of tea against each appropriate coupon in a form R.G.64 shall be ½ oz.

2. Where a form R.G.48 or R.G.48E relating to any rationed food is produced with a ration document the amount obtainable during the period of validity of such form against each appropriate coupon for that food -

(a) in the case of a form relating to cheese, shall be the amount specified on the form, or, where no amount is so specified, shall be 12 oz. for each special ration specified on the form. In each case the amount is in lieu of that specified in the table above;

(b) in any other case, shall be increased as specified on the form.

3. No tea is obtainable by virtue of a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 which contains no appropriate coupons for tea.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order, which comes into force on 10th August, 1952, -

- (a) reduces the butter ration so that the amount obtainable against each appropriate coupon in a General Ration Book R.B.1 and a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 shall be 2 oz;
- (b) reduces the amount of butter obtainable against an appropriate coupon in a Temporary Ration Card R.B.12 and a Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A from 3 oz. to 2 oz. and from 2 oz. to 1 oz. respectively;
- (c) increases from 4 oz. to 6 oz. the amount of margarine obtainable against each appropriate coupon in a General Ration Book R.B.1 and a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 relating to the week beginning 10th August, 1952 (week No. 13), and to each alternate week thereafter. The ration for each other week remains at 4 oz;
- (d) increases the amount of margarine obtainable against an appropriate coupon in a Temporary Ration Card R.B.12 and a Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A from 4 oz. to 5 oz. and from 2 oz. to 3 oz., respectively.
