THE COFFEE (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(REVOCATION) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Coffee (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 dated 30th May, 1951 (a) and the Coffee (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1952 dated 3rd May, 1952 (b) are hereby revoked, but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Coffee (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 26th day of August, 1952.
