THE IMPORTED ANIMAL FEEDINGSTUFFS (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949 (a), as amended (b), shall be further amended as follows:-
  - (1) In Article 1 thereof for the definition of "Agricultural Committee" there shall be substituted the following definition:-
 

"Committee" means as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney, the States of Guernsey Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries and as regards the Island of Alderney, the Alderney Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities.
  - (2) In Articles 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 thereof the word "Agricultural" shall be deleted.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 28th day of August, 1952.
