THE BACON (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT)
ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952 (a) shall be amended by substituting for paragraph (2) of Article 5 thereof the following paragraph:-

"(2) Any appropriate coupon for bacon in a General Ration Book R.B.1 or Child's Ration Book R.B.2 relating to any week shall be valid at any time during the ration period in which the week occurs".
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 5th day of October, 1952.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

This amending Order provides that bacon coupons in a General Ration Book R.B.1 and a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 relating to any week shall be valid for use at any time in the 4-week ration period in which the week occurs.
