STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

1952 No. 165

The Animal Products Importation Order No.2, 1952.

The States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section 10 of The Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952, (hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance) hereby order: -

1. The importation into the Island of the parts of carcasses specified in the Schedule hereto from any of the countries specified in the Third Schedule to the Principal Ordinance and which were first landed in the United Kingdom or Republic of Ireland is hereby permitted.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 7th day of October, 1952.

- (a) Lard or rendered fat.
- (b) Fully cured bacon and ham.
- (c) Sausages of the Salami type.
- (d) Cleaned and scraped sausage casings.
- (e) Pig products (cheeks, heads, feet, maws, tongues, rinds, and salt pork).
