THE MEAT (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 6)
ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952 (a) as amended (b) shall be amended by substituting for paragraphs 1, 2 and 4 of the Schedule thereto (which specifies the amount of the meat ration) the following paragraphs:-

"1. Amount against the appropriate coupons relating to each week in a -

General Ration Book R.B.1 Form R.B.12	}	1s. 11d. maximum price (11½d. maximum retail price for each coupon) or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey 3s. 2d. maximum price (1s. 7d. maximum retail price for each coupon).

2. Amount against each appropriate coupon in a -

Child's Ration Book R.B.2 Ration Book R.B.7 Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A	}	11½d. maximum retail price or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey 1s. 7d. maximum retail price.

4. Amount against an appropriate coupon on a form R.G.44.

1s. 10d. maximum retail price".

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in Article 1 of this Order or in Article 4 (1) of the Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952, the maximum quantity of meat which may be obtained or supplied against an appropriate coupon for meat in any of the ration documents mentioned in Article 1 of this Order relating to the week beginning 28th September, 1952, and valid for use during that week and the following week, but not used during the said week beginning 28th September, 1952, shall be 1s. 10d. maximum retail price in the case of any appropriate coupon on a form R.G.44 and 11½d. maximum retail price in any other case except where pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey is supplied when the maximum quantity of meat shall be 1s. 7d. maximum retail price.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
4. The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1952, dated 14th June, 1952 (c) and the Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 5) Order, 1952, dated 13th September, 1952 (d) are hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention of the Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952, as amended thereby.

5. This Order may be cited as the Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 6) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 5th day of October, 1952.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends the Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952.

In consequence of the reduction in the maximum retail price of meat from 5th October, 1952, the amount of the meat ration which may be obtained against appropriate coupons in a Ration Book R.B.1 and Form R.B.12 will be reduced from that date from 2s. 1d. to 1s. 11d. maximum retail price, or where locally produced pork is supplied, from 3s. 4d. to 3s. 2d. maximum retail price. The value of the appropriate coupons in the Child's Ration Book R.B.2, Ration Book R.B.7 and Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A will be reduced from 1s. 0 $\frac{1}{2}$ d. to 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ d. as from the same date or where locally produced pork is supplied, from 1s. 8d. to 1s. 7d. maximum retail price. For the same reason the value of the meat coupon on a form R.G.44 has been reduced as from the 5th October, 1952, from 2s. 1d. to 1s. 10d. maximum retail price.

In consequence of the reduction in the maximum retail prices of meat from 5th October, 1952, each coupons for meat in Ration Books R.B.1, R.B.2 and R.B.7 and Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A relating to the week beginning 28th September, 1952, but not used in that week will be valid if used in the week beginning 5th October, 1952, for 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ d. maximum retail price or where locally produced pork is supplied 1s. 7d. maximum retail price.
