THE MEAT PRODUCTS (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (NO. 2)
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Meat Products (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) Order, 1952 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended by substituting in the Second and Fourth Schedules thereto for the entries relating to uncooked sausages and sausage meat manufactured in the Bailiwick of Guernsey the entries set out in the Schedule hereto.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Meat Products (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 5th day of October, 1952.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

This amending Order reduces the maximum wholesale and retail prices of uncooked sausages and sausage meat manufactured in the Bailiwick of Guernsey consequent upon the reduction in the price of meat as from the 5th October, 1952.
