THE IMPORTED ANIMAL FEEDINGSTUFFS (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 4) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. The Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended by deleting from Part A of the Schedule thereto, the following entries:-

"Brewers' grains, wet."; and  
"Distillers' grains, wet."

- 2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
- 3. This Order may be cited as the Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 4) Order, 1952, and shall come into force on the 7th day of October, 1952.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order frees Brewers' and Distillers' wet grains from the provisions of the Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949.
