THE FATS AND CHEESE (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Fats and Cheese (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952 (a), shall be amended as follows:-
 - (a) by substituting, from the 30th day of November, 1952, for the entries relating to butter, margarine and cooking fats in the table in the Schedule to the said Order, which specifies the amount of the ration, the entries set out in the Schedule to this Order;
 - (b) by substituting, from the 25th day of January, 1953, for the weight "1 oz." where it appears in the said table in the second and third columns of the entry relating to cheese the weight "1½ oz."
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 30th day of November, 1952, and may be cited as the Fats and Cheese (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1952.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order -

- (a) increases from 2 oz. to 4 oz. the amount of butter which may be obtained against appropriate coupons in a General Ration Book R.B.1 and a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 relating to the week beginning 30th November, 1952, and to each alternate week thereafter;
- (b) increases from 30th November, 1952, the butter ration obtainable against appropriate coupons in a Temporary Ration Card R.B.12 and a Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A from 2 oz. to 3 oz. and from 1 oz. to 2 oz. respectively;
- (c) reduces, from the same date, the margarine ration obtainable against each appropriate coupon in a General Ration Book R.B.1 and a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 to a level 4 oz., in a Temporary Ration Card R.B.12 from 5 oz. to 4 oz. and in a Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A from 3 oz. to 2 oz.;
- (d) increases, from 25th January, 1953, the cheese ration obtainable against appropriate coupons in a General Ration Book R.B.1, a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 and a Temporary Ration Card R.B.12 from 1 oz. to 1 1/2 oz.
