The Poultry Carcasses (Importation) (No.3) Order, 1952.

The States of Guernsey Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section three of the Poultry Carcasses Importation Ordinance, 1951, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order: -

1. The importation directly into this Island of poultry carcasses from the Island of Jersey is hereby prohibited unless the poultry carcasses are fully plucked and unless each consignment is accompanied by a certificate, which shall be delivered to the States Supervisor, issued by the States of Jersey Committee of Agriculture to the effect that the said carcasses come from premises which are free from Foot and Mouth Disease.
2. The Poultry Carcasses (Importation) (No.2) Order, (a) of the 10th December, 1952, is hereby repealed.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 22nd December, 1952.
