THE GAS CHARGES (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1950.

Amended
by S.I. No. 46 of 1951*

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The maximum price exclusive of meter charges which the Guernsey Gas Light Co. Ltd. shall charge for gas supplied through the Company's service mains shall be 8/- per 1,000 cubic feet.
2. The Gas Charges (Guernsey) Order, 1948, ¹⁵⁶³ dated 29th November, 1948, is hereby revoked.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. (1) This Order shall come into operation on the date of the next reading of meters by the Guernsey Gas Light Co. Ltd. or the 1st day of January, 1951, whichever date shall be the earliest.
(2) This Order may be cited as The Gas Charges (Guernsey) Order, 1950.
