THE CHRISTMAS FOOD (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) DIRECTIONS, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945 and pursuant to Article 30 of The Food Rationing (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, as amended (a) we hereby issue the following Directions:-

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 4 of The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, as amended (b) which prescribes the fats and tea rations, the maximum quantity of cooking fats and tea which may be obtained or supplied for household consumption against an appropriate coupon specified, as respects cooking fats, in the First Schedule to this Order and, as respects tea, in the Second Schedule thereto shall be the amount specified in relation thereto in the said Schedules.
2. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 3 of The Rationing (Personal Points) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 (c), an appropriate coupon marked "D" shall represent $2\frac{1}{2}$ personal points in the following cases:-
 - (a) an appropriate coupon numbered 8 from a General Ration Book R.B.1, Child's Ration Book R.B.2, Junior Ration Book R.B.4 or Weekly Seaman's Book R.B.6;
 - (b) an un-numbered appropriate coupon (including an appropriate coupon marked R.B.12S) forming part of, or, as the case may be, produced in accordance with sub-paragraph (a) or (b) of paragraph (4) of Article 5 of the said Order, with a Form R.B.12, and valid under the terms of that Article at some time during Ration Period Number 8.
- (2) An appropriate coupon for personal points foods in any ration document relating to or valid for use at some time, but not used, during the ration period commencing 3rd December, 1950, shall be valid for use at any time during the ration period commencing 31st December, 1950.
3. Any person may supply or obtain sugar for household consumption in accordance with Article 4 of the said Food Rationing (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 (which regulates the obtaining and supply of rationed food for household consumption) as if the coupons specified in the first column of the Third Schedule to this Order were appropriate coupons for the purposes of that Article, valid during the period specified in relation thereto in the second column of the said Schedule, and as if the quantity of sugar prescribed in respect thereof were as specified in the third column of the said Schedule.
4. Nothing in Article 11 of the said Food Rationing (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, which relates to the invalidation by establishments of residents coupons, shall require or authorise the licensee of an establishment to invalidate the appropriate coupon for sugar in any person's ration document if the appropriate coupon which, but for the provisions of this Article, would fall to be invalidated under the terms of the said Article 11 is an appropriate coupon for sugar specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.

- 6. These Directions may be cited as The Christmas Food (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Directions, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 3rd day of December, 1950.

THE FIRST SCHEDULE.

Appropriate Coupon.

Amount of
Cooking Fats.

An appropriate coupon for fats -

(a) numbered 29, 30, 31 or 32 in a General Ration Book R.B.1, a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 or a Junior Ration Book R.B.4.

(b) in a Form R.B.12 if the whole or any part of the period specified on the form (or in the case of a double form on that half of the form of which the coupon forms part) falls within the ration period beginning 3rd December, 1950.

3 ozs.

THE SECOND SCHEDULE.

Appropriate Coupon.

Amount of Tea.

An appropriate coupon for tea numbered 29, 30, 31 or 32 in a form R.G.64.

2 ozs.

THE THIRD SCHEDULE.

First Column.

Second Column.

Third Column.

The coupon marked "R" forming part of the block of coupons numbered 8, opposite which the word "sugar" appears in a General Ration Book R.B.1, a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 or a Junior Ration Book R.B.4.

3rd December, 1950, to 30th December, 1950, inclusive.

1 lb. 8 ozs.

A coupon marked "Quarter R" in a Form R.B.12; if the whole or any part of the period specified on the form (or in the case of a double form on that half of the form of which the coupon forms part) falls within the period from 17th December, 1950, to 23rd December, 1950, inclusive.

The period specified on the form (or in the case of a double form on that half of the form of which the coupon forms part).

1 lb. 8 ozs.

NOTE: The quantity shown in the Third Column is the maximum amount which may be obtained against the coupons specified and no increase is permissible, notwithstanding that a Form R.G.48 is produced with the ration document.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Directions, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Directions make provision for extra rations for Christmas of cooking fats, sugar and sweets, and of tea for persons of 70 years of age and over.

Provision is also made for appropriate coupons for sweets valid for use at some time, but not used, during the four week period commencing 3rd December, 1950, to remain valid for use at any time during the succeeding four week period commencing 31st December, 1950.

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
