THE MEAT PRODUCTS AND CANNED MEAT (CONTROL AND MAXIMUM
PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 6)
ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Meat Products and Canned Meat (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended (a) shall be further amended by substituting in Section A of Part I of the Fourth Schedule thereto for the maximum prices of ls. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ d. per lb. and 2s. 0d. per lb. in respect of Corned beef, mutton or pork, the maximum prices of 2s. 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ d. per lb. and 2s. 8d. per lb. respectively.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Meat Products and Canned Meat (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 6) Order, 1950, and shall come into force on the 10th day of December, 1950.
