THE LINOLEUM AND PRINTED FELT BASE (MAXIMUM PRICES AND CHARGES)
(BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Linoleum and Printed Felt Base (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 (a) shall have effect subject to the following amendments to the First Schedule thereto:-
 - (i) for the particulars relating to Plain Linoleum (other than Brown) there shall be substituted the particulars contained in the First Schedule hereto;
 - (ii) to the particulars relating to Granites, Jaspé, Moiré and Sheet Marble Linoleum there shall be added the particulars contained in the Second Schedule hereto.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Linoleum and Printed Felt Base (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 15th day of January, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends The Linoleum and Printed Felt Base (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, as follows:-

- (1) Retailers' maximum prices for Plain Linoleum (other than Brown) are increased;
- (2) Retailers' maximum prices are fixed for a new type of Linoleum, namely "B" quality Jaspé.
