THE EGGS (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER,  
1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. (1) In this Order -

"Buy" includes offer or agree to buy and "sell" includes offer or agree to sell or expose for sale;

"Eggs" means the eggs in shell of domestic fowls and domestic ducks;

"Imported eggs" means eggs which have been imported into the Bailiwick of Guernsey from a place outside the British Islands.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

2. No person shall sell or buy any imported eggs at a price exceeding the maximum price applicable thereto in accordance with the provisions of the Schedule to this Order.

*S.I. 47 -* 3. The Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, dated 20th March, 1950 (a) and The Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1950, dated 12th September, 1950 (b) are hereby revoked.

4. This Order may be cited as The Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 22nd day of January, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order, which supersedes The Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, as amended, increases the maximum price of imported eggs to 4/6d. per dozen on a sale in the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and 4/9d. per dozen on a sale in the Island of Alderney.
