IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946.

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER,
1949, AMENDMENT NO. 1. ORDER, 1951.

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

- S.I. No. 45 (1949)*
1. There shall be inserted in the First Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, (a), the following item:-
"Caravans".
 2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
 3. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of February, 1951, and may be cited as the "Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment No. 1. Order, 1951".

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

The effect of this Order is that with effect from the 1st February, 1951, the importation into Guernsey of Caravans is prohibited save under licence issued by the Board of Administration.
