*REVOKED by S.I. 63 (1954)*THE IMPORTED WARE POTATOES (MAXIMUM PRICES) (GUERNSEY)
ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. In this Order -

"Buy" includes offer or agree to buy, and "sell" includes offer or agree to sell or expose for sale;

"Imported ware potatoes" means ware potatoes, other than seed or stockfeed potatoes, imported into the Island of Guernsey.

2. No person shall buy or sell any imported ware potatoes at a price exceeding 2½d. per lb.

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

4. This Order may be cited as The Imported Ware Potatoes (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 26th February, 1951.
