The Plants and Potatoes Importation Ordinance, 1951.

General Licence (I.P.F.Gen 1./1951.)

REPEALED by  
S.I. 1961(1950)

1. In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of The Plants and Potatoes Importation Ordinance, 1951, (a) the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries by this General Licence hereby authorises the landing or trans-shipment in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm or Jethou of consignments of the undermentioned plants grown in any European country, the United States of America or the Dominion of Canada.

4. All living plants and parts thereof (except seeds, flower bulbs, corms, tubers or rhizomes) for planting, provided that every consignment landed under the authority of this Licence shall be accompanied by a certificate in the form set out in the First Schedule and Second Schedule hereto, and provided also that in respect of

(a) the undermentioned plants and of buds of roses and grafts of apples, pears and rhododendrons:

(b) any trees, shrubs or plants with bare or balled roots and cuttings or grafts landed or transhipped between the 16th October in any year and the 31st March in the following year,

the consignment may be accompanied by a certificate in the form set out in the Third Schedule in place of the certificate in the form set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

B. Flower bulbs, corms, tubers or rhizomes, provided that every consignment landed or transhipped under the authority of this Licence shall be accompanied by a certificate in the form set out in the First Schedule hereto.

2. Provided that nothing in this Licence shall be deemed to permit the landing or transhipment of any plants the landing or transhipment of which is prohibited under paragraphs (ii), (iii), (iv) or (v) of Section 1 of The Plants and Potatoes Importation Ordinance, 1951 (a).

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 applies to the interpretation of this Licence as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

4. This Licence shall come into operation on the 21<sup>st</sup> February 1951.
