General Licence (I.P.F.Gen. 2./1951.)

1. In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Plants and Potatoes Importation Ordinance, 1951 (a), the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries by this General Licence hereby authorises the landing or trans-shipment in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm or Jethou of consignments of the undermentioned plants grown in any country.
  - A. Raw fruit. -Provided that -
    - (a) in respect of raw apples grown in the United States of America every consignment landed or transhipped under the authority of this Licence between the seventh day of July and the fifteenth day of November in any year shall be accompanied by a certificate of a duly authorised Inspector of the United States Department of Agriculture in the form set out in the First Schedule to this Licence; and
    - (b) in respect of cider apples grown in any European country, the United States of America or the Dominion of Canada every consignment landed or transhipped under the authority of this Licence between the first day of April and the fifteenth day of October in any year shall be accompanied by a certificate in the form set out in the Second Schedule to this Licence.
  - B. Cucumbers, marrows, mushrooms and pumpkins.
  - C. Raw vegetables, other than cucumbers, marrows, mushrooms and pumpkins-  
Provided that, in respect of raw vegetables grown in any European country, the United States of America or the Dominion of Canada, every consignment landed or transhipped under the authority of this Licence between the first day of April and the fifteenth day of October in any year shall be accompanied by a certificate -
    - (a) in respect of the undermentioned raw vegetables, in the form set out in the Third Schedule hereto: -
 

Root vegetables (excluding potatoes) free from foliage,	Onions and Shallots,
Asparagus,	Pimentos,
Aubergines,	Tomatoes,
Green Beans,	Witloof Chicory; and
Green Peas,	
    - (b) in respect of other raw vegetables, in the form set out in the Second Schedule hereto.
  - D. Nuts.
  - E. Cut flowers.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Licence as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Licence shall come into operation on the *24th* February 1951.
