THE FATS, CHEESE AND TEA (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER, 1951.

*Revoked S.I. 67 (1951)*

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

- S.I. 95*
1. The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 - (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended by substituting in the table in the Schedule thereto, which specifies the amount of the ration, for the entries relating to cheese the entries set forth in the Schedule to this Order. *S.I. 129 + S.I. 167*
  2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
  3. This Order may be cited as The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 28th day of January, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order increases, as from 28th January, 1951, the amount of cheese which may be obtained against appropriate coupons in a General Ration Book R.B.1, a Child's Ration Book R.B.2, a Junior Ration Book R.B.4, a Temporary Ration Card R.B.12 and a Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A.
