THE BACON (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 4)  
ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, (a), as amended (b), shall be further amended by substituting in the 2nd Column of the Schedule thereto (which specifies the amount of the bacon ration) for the amount "3 oz." in relation to each appropriate coupon in a General Ration Book R.B.1, a Junior Ration Book R.B.4, a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 and a Form R.B.12, the amount "4 oz."
2. Notwithstanding anything contained in Article 1 of this Order, the maximum amount of bacon which may be obtained or supplied against an appropriate coupon for bacon in any of the ration documents mentioned in Article 1 of this Order relating to the week commencing 21st January, 1951, and valid for use during the said week and the following week, but not used during the said week commencing 21st January, 1951, shall be 3 oz.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 28th day of January, 1951, and may be cited as the Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 4) Order, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order, which amends the Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, increases from 3 ozs. to 4 ozs. as from the 28th January, 1951, the amount of bacon which may be obtained against each appropriate coupon in Ration Books R.B.1, R.B.4 and R.B.2 and Form R.B.12.

Coupons for the week commencing 21st January, 1951, but not used in that week remain valid for use during the week commencing 28th January, 1951, but only for 3 ozs.
