THE RATIONING (PERSONAL POINTS) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)  
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Rationing (Personal points) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 (a) shall be amended by substituting for the First Schedule thereto, which specifies the number of points represented by an appropriate coupon, the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Rationing (Personal Points) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 25th day of February, 1951.

This amending Order increases the number of personal points available to consumers from 20 to 22 for each four-weekly ration period as from the 25th February, 1951.
