THE UTILITY QUILTS (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILIWICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

MAXIMUM PRICES.Retailer.

1. The maximum prices to be charged in the course of the business of a retailer, in respect of utility goods, being new utility quilts (hereinafter called "goods") shall be the aggregate of the following amounts:-
  - (i) the purchase price paid or agreed to be paid to the manufacturer or wholesaler by the first purchaser (being a retailer);
  - (ii) an amount equal to  $33\frac{1}{3}$ rd per cent of such price; and
  - (iii) an amount equal to  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent of the aggregate of the foregoing amounts;

so, however, that in respect of goods of a description included in the Schedule to this Order, such maximum price shall not exceed the appropriate amount specified in Column 2 thereof with the addition of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent.

GENERAL PROVISIONS.Rounding Provisions.

2. Notwithstanding anything in this Order, on a sale by a retailer of goods the maximum price of which, computed in accordance with the provisions of this Order, exceeds the sum of 5s., the maximum price per article shall be rounded to the nearest 1d. above it.

Interpretation and Revocation.

3. (1) In this Order -

"manufacturer" means any person who carries out a process of manufacture or making-up in relation to goods or who permits materials belonging to him to be subjected to any process whereby goods are produced;

"maximum price" means the price inclusive of any charges in respect of delivery to the premises of or nominated by the customer in the Island of Guernsey, before any deduction by way of discount;

"purchase price" means the price inclusive of all delivery charges payable after all deductions by way of discount other than cash or settlement discounts not exceeding 5 per cent.

"utility goods" has the meaning assigned in the Apparel and Textiles (Guernsey) Order, 1945.

- (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

(3) The Utility Quilts (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) Order, 1950, dated 4th July, 1950 (a) is hereby revoked.

Offences.

4. If any person sells, agrees to sell, or offers to sell, any goods in contravention of the provisions of this Order, he shall be guilty of an offence under this Order.

Citation and Commencement.

5. This Order may be cited as The Utility Quilts (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 12th day of March, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order supersedes The Utility Quilts (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) Order, 1950.

The principal changes are:-

- (i) Retailers' overriding maximum prices for all utility quilts are increased;
- (ii) the range of utility quilts is extended, and maximum and overriding maximum prices are provided for the new descriptions which are indicated in the Schedule by an asterisk (\*); and
- (iii) retailers' maximum prices are now inclusive of delivery charges to the premises of or nominated by the customer in the Island of Guernsey.
