THE RATIONING (PERSONAL POINTS) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Rationing (Personal Points) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 (a) as amended (b), shall be further amended by substituting for sub-paragraph (a) (i) of Article 2 thereof, the following sub-paragraph:-
"(i) the price on such sale, including the cost of container does not exceed ls. 10d. per lb. net in the case of chocolate and chocolate confectionery and 9d. per lb. net in the case of sugar confectionery."
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Rationing (Personal Points) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 25th day of March, 1951.

This amending Order increases from ls. 6d. to ls. 10d. per lb. the maximum price at which sub-standard chocolate and chocolate confectionery may under certain conditions be sold by the manufacturer points free.
