THE GAS CHARGES (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The maximum price exclusive of meter charges which the Guernsey Gas Light Co. Ltd. shall charge for gas supplied through the Company's service mains shall be 8/4d. per 1,000 cubic feet.
2. The Gas Charges (Guernsey) Order, 1950, dated 20th December, 1950 (a) is hereby revoked.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order may be cited as The Gas Charges (Guernsey) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 1st April, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.
