THE ADVERTISEMENT LIGHTING (PROHIBITION) (GUERNSEY)
(REVOCATION) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The Advertisement Lighting (Prohibition) (Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a) dated 30th January, 1951, is hereby revoked.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Advertisement Lighting (Prohibition) (Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1951, and shall come into force on the 28th day of March, 1951.
