IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946.  
-----The Import and Export of Goods (Control)  
(Guernsey) Order, 1949. Amendment Order 1951.

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. There shall be deleted from the First Schedule of the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, (a) the following item:-  
     ↓ S.I. 45, 1949.  
     "Tobacco and Tobacco Products".
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into force on the 19th day of April, 1951 and may be cited as the "Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment Order, 1951."

Explanatory Note.

The effect of the above order is that as from the 19th April, 1951, tobacco and tobacco products may be imported without licence from the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other islands of this Bailiwick and the Isle of Man. A licence to export these goods from Guernsey, however, must still be obtained from the Board of Administration, States Office.
