THE MEAT (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 8)
ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 (a), as amended (b), shall be further amended by substituting for paragraphs 1 and 2 of the Schedule thereto (which specifies the amount of the meat ration) the following paragraphs:-

"1. Amount against the appropriate coupons relating to each week in a -

General Ration Book R.B.1 ...	}	l1d. maximum price (5½d. maximum retail price for each coupon) or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey, 2/9d. maximum price (1/4½d. maximum retail price for each coupon.)
Junior Ration Book R.B.4 ...		
Form R.B.12 ...		

2. Amount against each appropriate coupon in a -

Child's Ration Book R.B.2 ...	}	5½d. maximum retail price or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey, 1/4½d. maximum retail price."
Ration Book R.B.7 ...		
Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A ...		

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 8) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 15th day of April, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order reduces, as from 15th April, 1951, the amount of the meat ration which may be obtained against appropriate coupons in Ration Books R.B.1 and R.B.4 and Form R.B.12 from 1s. Od. to l1d. maximum retail price. The value of the appropriate coupons in the Child's Ration Book R.B.2, Ration Book R.B.7 and Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A is reduced from 6d. to 5½d.

This Order follows the decision to issue the whole of the meat ration in carcass meat and is necessary in view of the special ration value of coupons when canned corned meat is supplied.
