THE EXPORT OF TOMATOES (ZONING) (1951) ORDER.

The States Committee for Horticulture, in pursuance of paragraph 5 of "The Export of Tomatoes, 1951, No. 2 Order" (a), hereby orders:-

1. For the purposes of this Order, the Island is divided into two zones as follows:-

From the Grand Bouet, Vrangue, Ramee, Longue Rue, turn left into the Landes du Marche as far as the Chapel, turn right along Charruee Road, then Carteret Road to the coast. All glasshouse properties on the right-hand side and to the north of these roads will be in the Northern Zone.

All properties to the South of the above-mentioned roads will be in the Southern Zone.

2. For the week ending 19th May, tomatoes will be shipped as follows:-

Tuesday, May 15th. Tomatoes packed in both zones will be shipped on this day.

Wednesday, May 16th. Northern Zone.

Thursday, May 17th. Southern Zone.

Friday, May 18th. Northern Zone.

Saturday, May 19th. Southern Zone.

3. The shipping days for the zones from Wednesday, May 16th, until further notice are therefore as follows:-

Northern Zone - Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Southern Zone - Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.

4. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Order, Packers may, by arrangement with the Guernsey Tomato Shipping Board, be given facilities for shipping a proportion of their produce each day of the week.
