

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a) as amended (b), shall have effect subject to the amendment that for the First and Third Schedules thereto there shall be substituted respectively the First and Second Schedules to this Order.
2. The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1951 dated 19th March, 1951 (c) and The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1951, dated 3rd April, 1951 (d) are hereby revoked.
3. This Order may be cited as The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 3rd May, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, which fixes retailers' maximum prices for utility apparel.

The Order brings into force Related Schedule No. 5H which contains retailers' overriding maximum prices for utility industrial overalls and aprons. The changes effected by the Related Schedules are indicated in the Explanatory Notes issued therewith. It also removes from the list of Related Schedules Nos. 1K and 3J which do not apply.

The Order also amends the principal Order by fixing maximum prices for some new descriptions of women's utility hose.
