THE COFFEE (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. (1) In this Order -

"Coffee" includes coffee mixture (except where the context otherwise requires) but does not include any essence or extract of coffee or of coffee and chicory, or any preparation of coffee and milk;

"Coffee mixture" means any mixture containing coffee which is commonly sold under the name of coffee, or of coffee and chicory mixture;

"Sell" includes offer or agree to sell or expose for sale, and "buy" includes offer or agree to buy;

"The Committee" means the States of Guernsey Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

2. (1) No person shall buy or sell coffee by retail at a price exceeding a price calculated at the rate of -

(a) (i) 4s. 3d. per lb. for roasted coffee, or

(ii) 3s. 7d. per lb. for coffee mixture.

when packed in containers containing not more than $\frac{1}{4}$ lb. each;

(b) (i) 4s. 2d. per lb. for roasted coffee, or

(ii) 3s. 6d. per lb. for coffee mixture,

when packed in containers containing more than $\frac{1}{4}$ lb. each; or

(c) 3s. 7d. per lb. for raw coffee (other than coffee mixture):

Provided that any person may buy or sell coffee by retail at a price exceeding the above prices, but not exceeding the price applicable in accordance with Part I of the Schedule to this Order, if the appropriate condition in Part II of the said Schedule is complied with.

(2) Except as is expressly provided in the Schedule to this Order no addition to the maximum prices specified in this Article or in the said Schedule shall be made, on a sale of coffee by retail, in respect of grinding or packing or of packages or containers.

3. No person shall manufacture any coffee mixture, prepare any coffee mixture by way of trade, or sell any coffee mixture by retail, unless it contains not less than 51 per cent by weight of pure coffee.

4. (1) Every person who sells coffee by retail shall keep or cause to be kept an accurate record of all purchases of coffee by him; and such record shall include, in respect of each purchase, the date thereof, the name and address of the person from whom the coffee was purchased, the description and quantity of coffee purchased, and the price paid.

- (2) The retention by any person of an invoice or of a copy of an invoice shall as regards the particulars mentioned therein be a sufficient compliance by him with the provisions of this Article.
- (3) Every person who is required by this Article to keep any record shall retain it for one year from the date of the transaction to which it relates.
5. This Order shall not apply to the sale or purchase of coffee in the form of a beverage.
6. No person shall, in connection with the sale or disposition or proposed sale or disposition of any coffee by retail, enter or offer to enter into any artificial transaction or make or demand any unreasonable charge.
7. (1) The provisions of this Order are subject to any directions which may at any time be made by or on behalf of the Committee, and to any licence or authorisation which may be granted by or on behalf of the Committee under this Order.
(2) Every person holding a licence or authorisation granted under this Order shall comply with every condition imposed by such licence or authorisation.
(3) Every licence or authorisation granted under this Order is, and shall remain, the property of the Committee; and the licensee or any person being in possession of any such licence or authorisation shall, if requested to do so by or on behalf of the Committee, produce or deliver it to such person or to a person of such class or description, and within such time, as may be specified in the request.
8. Infringements of this Order are offences against the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945.
9. (1) The Coffee (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, dated 9th September, 1950 (a) is hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.
(2) Every person shall, notwithstanding the revocation of the said Order, retain any record required to be kept by him thereunder for one year from the date of the transaction to which it relates.
10. This Order may be cited as The Coffee (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, and shall come into force on the 31st day of May, 1951.

THE SCHEDULE.

PART I.

Maximum Retail Price of Coffee when the Conditions in Part II are complied with.

The maximum retail price of coffee, when the appropriate condition in Part II of this Schedule is complied with, shall be in accordance with the following table:-

For the purposes of the above table, "pre-packed" means packed in advance ready for retail sale.

THE SCHEDULE

PART II.

Conditions.

1. Roasted coffee or coffee mixture.

Throughout the whole time during which roasted coffee or coffee mixture is being offered for sale at the appropriate price specified in Part I of this Schedule -

(a) the seller shall be able and willing to sell to any customer, to the extent of that customer's reasonable requirements, either -

(i) roasted coffee at a price not exceeding 4s. 2d. per lb. (or 4s. 3d. if packed in containers containing not more than $\frac{1}{4}$ lb. each); or

(ii) coffee mixture at a price not exceeding 3s. 6d. per lb. (or 3s. 7d. if packed in containers containing not more than $\frac{1}{4}$ lb. each); and

(b) there shall be displayed at the place of sale (except in the case of a sale from a vehicle), in a conspicuous position and so as to be clearly legible by customers, a notice stating in plain words and figures either -

(i) that roasted coffee is on sale at a price (which shall be specified in the notice) not exceeding 4s. 2d. per lb. (or 4s. 3d. if packed in containers containing not more than $\frac{1}{4}$ lb. each); or

(ii) that coffee mixture is on sale at a price (which shall be specified in the notice) not exceeding 3s. 6d. per lb. (or 3s. 7d. if packed in containers containing not more than $\frac{1}{4}$ lb. each).

2. Raw coffee.

Throughout the whole time during which raw coffee is being offered for sale at the appropriate price specified in Part I of this Schedule -

(a) the seller shall be able and willing to sell to any customer, to the extent of that customer's reasonable requirements, raw coffee at a price not exceeding 3s. 7d. per lb.; and

(b) there shall be displayed at the place of sale (except in the case of a sale from a vehicle), in a conspicuous position and so as to be clearly legible by customers, a notice stating in plain words and figures that raw coffee is on sale at a price (which shall be specified in the notice) not exceeding 3s. 7d. per lb.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order replaces The Coffee (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, and raises the maximum retail prices of roasted coffee, coffee mixture and raw coffee.

The increases vary (according to the size and type of container) from 10d. to 1s. 5d. for roasted coffee, from 3d. to 10d. for coffee mixture, and from 8d. to 10d. for raw coffee.
