THE UTILITY APPAREL (MAXIMUM PRICES AND CHARGES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 4) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a) as amended (b), shall have effect subject to the following amendments to the Third Schedule:-
 - (a) in Column 1 of that Schedule, the words "Women's and maids' underwear and nightwear (other than knitted apparel)" and "Gaberdine raincoats" shall be omitted, and
 - (b) in Column 2 of that Schedule, the words "Related Schedule No. 4L" and "Related Schedule No. 16C" shall be omitted.
2. This Order may be cited as The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 4) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 21st day of June, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 as amended, by omitting Related Schedules Nos. 4L and 16C which contained overriding maximum prices for Women's and maids' underwear and nightwear (other than knitted apparel) and Gaberdine raincoats respectively.

Consequently the maximum prices to be charged by a retailer for such utility apparel are now to be computed solely by reference to the price paid together with the appropriate percentage.
