THE UTILITY FOOTWEAR (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The maximum price to be charged in the course of the business of a retailer in respect of footwear described in Column 1 and bearing a code number included in Column 2 of the First Schedule hereto, being utility goods (which footwear is in this Order referred to as "goods"), shall be the appropriate amount specified in Column 3 of that Schedule.
2. The amounts specified in Column 3 of the First Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be adjusted as follows:-
 - (i) in relation to women's and men's footwear of a size or a fitting, or of a size and a fitting, specified in the Second Schedule hereto, each such amount shall be deemed to be increased by the appropriate percentage, or, as the case may be, the sum of the appropriate percentages, specified in the said Second Schedule;
 - (ii) in relation to goods marked "substandard", each such amount, increased in accordance with the provisions of head (i) of this Article (where applicable), shall be deemed to be reduced by 20 per cent thereof.
3. (1) In this Order -

"maximum price" means the price payable before any deductions by way of discount, except that in calculating the maximum price to be charged on a sale of any goods by retail, the cost actually paid or incurred of delivering those goods to the buyer thereof may be excluded;

"utility goods" has the meaning assigned thereto in The Apparel and Textiles (Guernsey) Order, 1945.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
4. The Utility Footwear (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, (a) is hereby revoked.
5. This Order may be cited as The Utility Footwear (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 2nd day of July, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order supersedes The Utility Footwear (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950.

The principal changes are as follows:-

- (1) The maximum prices for all grades of footwear are increased.
- (2) Men's Grade 1 heavy boots have now been added to the descriptions in the First Schedule.
- (3) Some reductions have been made in the percentage additions for large sizes.
