THE GENERAL FOOD (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1951

REVOKED by S.I. 129 (1952)

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. (1) In this Order -

"Food" means commodities of any description specified in the Schedule to this Order, but does not include commodities imported direct from France;

"Sale by retail" means any sale other than to a person buying for the purposes of resale and includes a sale to a person for the purpose of his catering business or for ships' stores but does not include a sale to a manufacturer;

"Buy" includes offer or agree to buy and "sell" includes offer or agree to sell or expose for sale;

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

2. No person shall sell by retail or buy by retail any food at a price exceeding the maximum price applicable thereto in accordance with the provisions of the Schedule to this Order;

Provided that in calculating such maximum price any fraction of a half-penny shall be regarded as a half-penny.

3. No person shall in connection with a sale or disposal or proposed sale or disposal of any food enter into any artificial or fictitious transaction or make or demand any charge in excess of the Schedule price.

4. The following Orders are hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof:-

- (1) The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, dated 22nd July, 1950 (a).
- (2) The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1950, dated 1st August, 1950 (b).
- (3) The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1950, dated 5th August, 1950 (c).
- (4) The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1950, dated 25th October, 1950 (d).

5. This Order may be cited as The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, and shall come into force on the 13th day of July, 1951.
