THE EGGS (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended by substituting in the Schedule thereto, for the maximum price of "4s. 0d. per dozen" in relation to Imported eggs on a sale in the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney, the maximum price of "4s. 6d. per dozen" and for the maximum price of "4s. 3d. per dozen" in relation to Imported eggs on a sale in the Island of Alderney, the maximum price of "4s. 9d. per dozen."
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 28th day of July, 1951.

This Order increases the maximum price of eggs by 6d. per dozen to 4s. 6d. per dozen on a sale in the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and to 4s. 9d. per dozen on a sale in the Island of Alderney.
