THE EXPORT OF OUTDOOR TOMATOES ORDER, 1951.

The States' Committee for Horticulture, under and by virtue of "The Export of Tomatoes Law, 1949", as extended by "The Export of Tomatoes Law, 1949, (Continuance) Law, 1950", for the purpose of ensuring the orderly and expeditious marketing of tomatoes from Guernsey in 1951 hereby orders:-

1. All consignments of outdoor grown tomatoes intended for export must be consigned on a separate Shipping Board Advice Note.
2. All packages of outdoor tomatoes must be loaded on or near the rear of each vehicle in order to be readily accessible for inspection.
3. Packages of outdoor tomatoes intended for export shall be labelled at each end, by the packer, with a label indicating that the contents are outdoor grown.
4. All outdoor grown tomatoes are subject to the same regulations, including grading and papering of containers, as those relating to the export of indoor grown tomatoes.
5. This Order shall come into force on Friday, 24th August, 1951.
