Colorado Beetle (No.2) Order, 1951.

Revocation Order

Under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by Article 3 of the Loi relative au Doryphore (anglicé Colorado Beetle) 1933, the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries hereby orders as follows: -

1. The Colorado Beetle (No.1) Order, 1951, (a) dated 18th June, 1951, is hereby revoked.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 31st August, 1951.

Explanatory Note.

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order removes, with effect from the 31st August, 1951, the restrictions on the removal of seaweed from any of the beaches or foreshores around the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.
