THE UTILITY CLOTH AND UTILITY HOUSEHOLD TEXTILES (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (NO. 2) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

PART I.

MAXIMUM PRICES.

1. The maximum price to be charged in the course of the business of a retailer in respect of utility goods shall be -
  - (1) in the case of cloth (hereinafter called "goods") of a description specified in Column 1 of the First Schedule hereto, the appropriate amount specified in Column 2 of that Schedule with the addition of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent of such amount;
  - (2) in the case of cloth (including lace and woven curtain net) to which paragraph (1) of this Article does not apply and household textiles (other than bedding) (hereinafter called "goods"), the aggregate of the following amounts:-
    - (a) the purchase price paid or agreed to be paid to the manufacturer or to the wholesaler, by the first purchaser (being a retailer);
    - (b) an amount equal to the appropriate percentage of such price specified in Column 2 of Part I of the Second Schedule hereto; and
    - (c) an amount equal to  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent of the aggregate of the foregoing amounts;

Provided that the maximum price of goods of a description specified in Column 1 of the appropriate Part of the Third Schedule hereto shall not exceed the appropriate amount specified in Column 2 of such Part of that Schedule with the addition of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent of such amount.
2. The variations of overriding maximum prices specified in Part III of the Third Schedule hereto shall have effect as therein provided.
3. Notwithstanding anything in this Order on a sale by retail -
  - (i) of any article of goods (not being cloth) the maximum price of which, computed in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order, does not exceed the sum of 5s., the maximum price shall be rounded to the nearest half-penny;
  - (ii) of any article of goods (not being cloth) the maximum price of which, computed as aforesaid, exceeds the sum of 5s., the maximum price shall be rounded to the nearest penny;
  - (iii) of goods (being cloth) the maximum price of which, per yard, computed in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order, does not exceed the sum of 5s., the maximum price per yard shall be rounded to the nearest half-penny;

- (iv) of goods (being cloth) the maximum price of which, per yard, computed as aforesaid, exceeds the sum of 5s., the maximum price per yard shall be rounded to the nearest penny;

Provided that the maximum price, when rounded, of goods of a description specified in Column 1 of the appropriate Part of the Third Schedule hereto shall not exceed the appropriate amount specified in Column 2 of such Part of that Schedule with the addition of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent of such amount.

PART II.

GENERAL PROVISIONS.

4. (1) A specification number set out in sub-column (a) of Column 1 of the First Schedule hereto or in Part II of the Second Schedule hereto or in sub-column (a) of Column 1 of the Third Schedule hereto refers to cloth or household textiles being utility goods described in relation to that specification number in any Schedule to any Order made by the Board of Trade.

(2) The provisions of this Order shall not apply to second-hand utility goods.

5. (1) In this Order -

"bedding" has the meaning assigned to it in The Apparel and Textiles (Guernsey) Order, 1945, as amended;

"the Board of Trade" means the Board of Trade of the United Kingdom;

"household textiles" means textile articles (other than utility upholstery cloth and utility curtain cloth) of a kind used for domestic purposes, and tissues and fabrics, whether in the piece, shaped or partly made up, intended or designed for making such articles;

"manufacturer" means any person, who carries out a process of manufacture, in relation to goods, or who procures or permits materials belonging to him to be subjected to any process whereby goods are produced;

"maximum price" means the price inclusive of all delivery charges, payable before any deduction by way of discount; "purchase price" means the price payable after all deductions by way of discount, other than cash or settlement discounts not exceeding five per cent and inclusive of all delivery charges to quay Guernsey;

"utility goods" has the meaning assigned to it in The Apparel and Textiles (Guernsey) Order, 1945, as amended.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

(3) The Orders mentioned in the Fourth Schedule hereto are hereby revoked.

6. This Order may be cited as The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) Order, 1951, and shall come into force on the 13th day of August, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order supersedes The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, as amended.

The principal changes are as follows:-

- (1) Maximum prices for all utility cotton and rayon quilt cloths included in the First Schedule have been increased, prices being now specified per square yard instead of per linear yard. A maximum price has also been fixed for a cotton quilt cloth (Specification No. 7502) with a dyed finish.
- (2) Retailers' permitted margins have been fixed for a number of new descriptions of woven rayon cloths, one new description of linen dress cloth and 31 new descriptions of curtain cloths recently introduced into the Utility range. The specification numbers of the rayon cloths and the linen dress cloth (6005/1) are included in Section A of Part II of the Second Schedule and those of the curtain cloths are set out in Sections E and F of Part II of the Second Schedule.
- (3) Only one retailers' permitted margin is provided in Part I of the Second Schedule for all utility blankets of wool or other animal fibre, irrespective of the purchase price per lb.
- (4) The Third Schedule, which replaces Related Schedule No. 5L, fixes retailers' overriding maximum prices ("ceiling prices") for all utility household textiles specified in Parts I and II of that Schedule. All ceiling prices have been increased, except those for table cloths of specification numbers 7700/1, 7700/2, 7700/3 and 7700/4.
