THE BACON (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT
NO. 2) ORDER, 1951.

REVOKED in S.I. 115 (1952)

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a) as amended (b), shall be further amended by substituting for paragraph (2) of Article 5 thereof the following paragraph:-
"(2) Any appropriate coupon for bacon in a General Ration Book R.B.1 or Child's Ration Book R.B.2 shall be valid only during the week to which it relates and during each succeeding week, if any, in the ration period in which the week to which the coupon relates occurs."
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 9th day of September, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order extends the validity of the bacon coupons in the General Ration Book R.B.1 and the Child's Ration Book R.B.2 to enable holders of such books to obtain up to four weeks supply of their bacon ration at one time in any 4-week ration period provided they do not obtain the bacon in advance of the week to which the coupons relate. Coupons valid for use, but not used, in one 4-week ration period may not be used in any succeeding period.
