IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946.The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order,
1949.Amendment No. 3 Order, 1951.

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. There shall be deleted from the Second Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, (a), the item -
"Carpets, rugs and mats of every description"
2. There shall be deleted from the Delegation of Power to Grant Export Licences (No. 1.) Order, 1949, (b), the item -
"Carpets, rugs and mats".
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of September, 1951, and may be cited as the "Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment No. 3, Order, 1951".
