*Revised by S.I. 30 (1952)*THE FUEL (MAXIMUM PRICES) (GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a) shall be amended by substituting for the maximum prices of "6s. 3d." and "5s. 9d." in relation to Anthracite Coal (large) for use other than for Horticultural purposes, the maximum prices of "6s. 6d." and "6s. 0d." respectively.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1951, and shall come into force on the 3rd day of September, 1951.
