THE GENERAL FOOD (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1951.

REVOKED by S.I. 129 (1952)

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a) as amended (b), shall be further amended as follows:-

(1) by adding at the end of Article 1 (1) thereof, the following definition:-

"The Committee" means the States of Guernsey Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities.

(2) by substituting for Article 2 thereof the following Article:-

"Except under the authority of the Committee no person shall sell by retail or buy by retail any food at a price exceeding the maximum price applicable thereto in accordance with the provisions of the Schedule to this Order:

Provided that in calculating such maximum price any fraction of a half-penny shall be regarded as a half-penny."

(3) by substituting for Part V of the Schedule thereto, the Schedule to this Order.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

3. This Order may be cited as The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1951, and shall come into force on the 3rd day of September, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order -

- (1) gives the States of Guernsey Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities power to authorise the charging of prices in excess of those prescribed;
- (2) increases the maximum prices of imported canned salmon; and
- (3) frees imported canned pilchards, crawfish, barracouta and tunny from price-control.
